



### **SEWER UPDATE**

I Just wanted to take a moment to update everyone on the status of our sewer problems. As most of you know we had a sewer line break under the house on Lot 134 back at the end of January. As a result of the location of the break the house had to be split and moved off of the lot. The break has been repaired, a new pad poured for the house and today March 22, the house is going back on the lot. At the Board Meeting last Saturday March 16th, we approved the bills and paid most of the cost incurred with this unexpected problem. We had a total of \$ 171,000.00 in the sewer and water reserve account. After paying the bills we have depleted the account and only have about \$3,500 left in account #524. We still need to pay Winter Haven RV that removed and is now replacing the house to the lot. The estimate for this is \$25,000-\$30,000. With the account almost gone we need to look at ways to replenish this money and move forward on fixing the sewer system that has been neglected for too many years. We are discussing different options that we may have to tackle this situation. As soon as something is decided the Board will let the home owners know. We can no longer ignore this problem and hope it goes away. We have too much invested here at ORO.

# CHECKLIST FOR CLOSING YOUR HOME

- Please tie-down or tuck away **anything** that can blow around and hurt or damage property; i.e., flower pots, lawn ornaments, bikes, chairs, tables, water cans, BBQ grills, etc.
- Remove anything from your refrigerators or freezers that may spoil if we lose electricity.
- Be sure that you have given the office your current telephone number (including area code) and address as well as an emergency contact.
- Please notify the mailroom when you are leaving and give instruction regarding mail forwarding.
- When covering golf carts, please get a ready-made or at least a canvas cover. The plastic ones deteriorate within a month or so and become unsightly. If this happens, we will remove and dispose of them.
- Please do not put plywood and other materials around your automobile tires. This is very unsightly. Please purchase regular wheel covers.
- If you have flowerbeds or shrubs you want to keep, please arrange for someone to care for them. Maintenance will not pull weeds from your personal flower beds in the summer.
- Get rain gauges for irrigation (required by State law) and set sprinklers for proper days and times.
- Please consider your neighbors who stay at ORO year-round. Let's keep the park nice all year long.

### UP TO A WEEK BEFORE LEAVING

- Have mail forwarded by the Post Office.
- Change or wash the air-conditioning filter.
- Trim shrubs and vines growing near the house.
- Clear debris from the gutter and roof.
- Spray for bugs or hire an exterminator.

- Make sure the Office has your phone numbers & keys to your unit in case of emergency.
- Stop the paper and other deliveries.
- Notify publishers to forward magazines.
- Arrange for vacation-rate utility service.

### FROM ONE WEEK TO ONE DAY BEFORE LEAVING

- Clean and wax appliances.
- Throw away opened foods and perishables.
- Wash kitchen cabinet exteriors and wipe out interiors.
- Clean the oven, broiler and surface drip tray.
- Wash out the refrigerator's interior and drip tray.
- Clean out the dishwasher filter, run a short wash cycle & unlatch door.
- Clean the garbage disposal with ice cubes and baking soda.
- Dust and wax wood furniture.
- Vacuum carpet and upholstery and remove spots.
- Vacuum mattresses and cover them lightly with a sheet.
- Give houseplants to a neighbor.

### THE DAY YOU LEAVE

- Turn off the refrigerator and prop open the doors.
- Turn off the water heater.
- Cover exhaust vents with plastic wrap.
- Close and lock all windows.
- Cover toilets and their tanks with plastic wrap and put stoppers in all the drains.
- Turn off the telephone answering machine.

- Set the air-conditioner thermostat and the timer if you have one.
- Set timers on lights, if desired.
- Flip off breakers of circuits not in use or unplug electrical items.
- Turn off water at the main shutoff.
- Set the burglar alarm, if you have one.
- Lock all doors.
- Please remember when putting up window coverings to place the side with lettering to the inside of the home; in other words, no writing should show on the outside of your home. Please refer to Rules and Regulations Page 12, Section R, #3.

# Storage

Storage has been having issues with unit owners purchasing cargo trailers without being on a storage waitlist or being far down on a waitlist and the owners want to leave their items on a temporary spot.

If you have not been assigned a lot or are not on a waitlist please do not expect to be able to leave your item in storage until your name comes up on the list. This also applies to boats in the marina. If you do not have a storage site to place your boat trailer on and there is room in temporary storage you may place the trailer there for the season not on a permanent basis. If there is no room in temporary storage you must store your trailer off site. Temporary Storage is not a year round storage site.

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# **Hurricane Preparedness**

It's that time of year again, Hurricanes! In the event that a hurricane comes through ORO, we will assess all damages in the park. After all assessments have been completed all damages and photos will be placed on our website. We will make every effort to contact all owners via phone or email with major damages. For those of you still here in the park, below is a list of items to keep on hand during this season:

Water—at least 1 gallon daily per person for 3-7 days.

Food—At least enough for 3-7 days non-perishable package or canned food juices, snacks, non electric can opener, cooking utensils, cooking fuel, paper plates & plastic utensils.

Blankets, Pillows, Toiletries, Hygiene items, Moisture Wipes, First Aid Kit, Medicines and Prescription drugs for at least 3-7 days.

Flash light, batteries, radio, cell phone (fully charged or adapter for car use).

Cash (many ATM's and Banks may not be able to process cards for you).

Pet food & water for at least 3-7 days

Fill you cars gas tank.

Keep important documents in a water proof container.

Make sure you know where the closest shelter is that will suit your needs.

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
