Here are our Top 5 tips for saving money on your energy bill this summer. Avoid the shockingly high bills, high temps can bring.

1. Have your AC Serviced

AC units need regular maintenance to run efficiently. Make sure your unit is in tip top shape and ready for the heat!

2. Get out of the Kitchen

Using the oven will certainly warm up the house, causing your cooling bill to go up too! Become a grill master and remember to use those slow cookers this summer to avoid using the oven when possible.

3. Close the Curtains

Keep your blinds or drapes closed on west and south facing windows during the day. This will keep your home significantly cooler.

4. Change that Air Filter

A dirty air filter can increase energy use up to 15%, according to Duke Energy! If your using you're AC constantly you need to change it more often.

5. Seal Windows and Doors

Doors and Windows with poor seals will let cool air escape and heat to enter. Make sure appropriate weather proofing is in place.



WEED CONTROL

Please remember that you are responsible for the weeds in your yards, gardens, pads and driveways, even when you are not in the park. Please make arrangements to have your weeds taken care of while out of town.



WATERING SCHEDULE

If your address ends in an even number, you may water your lawn two (2) days a week on Thursday or Sunday. If your address ends in an odd number, you may water your lawn two (2) days a week on Wednesday or Saturday.

<u>A Note From The President</u>

Happy Summer ORO Owners,

Can you believe it is July already? It seems we just started 2021! The past three months have been busy in ORO.

- We received the report of the smoke testing that was completed in February. Our maintenance staff repaired 28 problem areas where broken laterals were repaired. The repairs were ORO's responsibility. Many letters have been sent and more are going out to owners with issues they are responsible for. We are waiting for an estimate to proceed to the next step of scoping some of the areas that are a problem.
- The water tank behind the small pool passed the 5- year checkup testing per Florida law.
- The treatment plant underwent a flowmeter upgrade. This meter records the water flow into the plant for reporting to the DES in Florida.
- Maintenance personnel had two days of OSHA training for safety when entering lift stations and manholes. All participants received a certificate. Congratulations to the maintenance team members.

We opened the clubhouse at 50% capacity on June 1st. It is great to see the building being used again. Here is the list of items that have been completed or being worked on to maintain the building.

- The downstairs carpet was cleaned.
- The pool wall under the overhang is receiving the stones that were voted on at an earlier annual meeting. It is coming along well and looks great.
- One of the air handlers was replaced. It broke down two days before the clubhouse opened.
- The window tinting project in the upstairs clubhouse has started. This is an ongoing project to be completed in the next four weeks.
- We are pursuing the addition of a unisex bathroom upstairs in the clubhouse.

The staff in the office has changed quite a bit over the past three months. New staff members are being trained on ORO's rules and regulations.

- We hired a new Park Manager. Gail Spence comes to us from the Lake Wales area and is working diligently to get the office up to speed as well as learning the Park.
- New Customer Service Representative Teri Jo Rojas is the counter person.
- Leslie Michaels is working the rental program which was restarted May 1^{st.}
- The new roof on the office was completed this week and looks great.
- The entrance and RV parking signs were updated.
- We continue to work on the financials to get them up to date and correct.
- We will be attending the variance hearings on July 21 and report the results to the owners.

This is a partial list of items that have been accomplished. I would like to thank the ORO staff in departments for their hard work and diligence to make ORO the best that it can be.

Please have a safe summer, and we hope to see you all in fall.

Summer in Orlando is known for long, hot, humid days with afternoon thunderstorms. According to AccuWeather, Florida averages 3,500 cloud to ground lightning flashes per day and 1.2 million flashes per year. More people get struck and killed by lightning in Florida than any other state. The combination of heat, humidity and sea breezes on both the Gulf and Atlantic coasts makes the perfect breeding ground for thunderstorms.

Seek shelter immediately, whether a building, a house, or a car. You are safer inside than outside. Be sure to get rid of any dead or rotting trees/branches that could fall and cause injury. If indoors when lightning occurs, stay away from water or wet items and metal objects.

Be safe out there!





2021 HURRICANE SEASON

The 2021 Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30. The areas covered include the Atlantic Ocean, Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean Sea.

The National Weather Service defines a hurricane as a "tropical cyclone with maximum sustained winds of 74 mph (64 knots) or higher."



Hurricanes are rated according to intensity of sustained winds on the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale. The 1-5 scale estimates potential property damage.

A Category 3 or higher is considered a major hurricane.

The National Hurricane Center advises preparedness:

A hurricane watch indicates the possibility that a region could experience hurricane conditions within 48 hours.

A hurricane warning indicates that sustained winds of at least 74 mph are expected within 36 hours.
