President's Projects Update

As we start the second half of 2022, I would like to update you on a project that is completed and some new ones we are working on. As of this letter, the sewer line at lot 127 has been fixed, cement pad poured, house placed back where it belongs, and the Millers moved back in. We thank the Millers for their patience during this necessary project.

The next sewer issue is on the backside of the 8th green of the golf course. Brownie's Sewer Repair Company scoped the sewer line in that area and we are waiting for an estimate to unplug the pipe loaded with sand and repair the hole in the top of the pipe.

The office staff is in the process of scanning all documents and saving them to the server which is then backed up daily to the cloud. Our hope is to make the office paperless. Procedures are being worked on and updated by all department heads and submitted to Gail for review and changes.

Financials are in decent shape. We are seeing some substantial increases in fuel, insurance and electric bills and we are adjusting to reduce the impact on the budget.

The BOD will be divided into two teams. One team will review the dog rules and submit ways of enforcing the rules. Remember, the rules state 1 pet per household not 2, not 3. That team will produce a new registration form as our documents state that all pets must be registered with the office. The second team will review the fence rules and submit any changes or enforcement to the whole board by the beginning of October. Gail and I will be reviewing the rules and regulations booklet as printed from 2018 and submit to the BOD any changes needed by October.

Other projects are the soundproofing of the pickleball and tennis courts and replacing the

deteriorating planter by the big drain on the backside of the big pool and tennis courts.

So, as you can see we have been keeping remarkably busy since the snowbirds flew north and will continue until they come back!

We hope everyone has a great summer and please be safe. We look forward to seeing you when you return.

RENTAL PROGRAM YEAR IN REVIEW

After more than a year with the program suspended due to Covid-19, the Rental Program was relaunched on May 1, 2021. The program continues to improve and has expanded to currently have 18 homes and 25 RV lots. We have built on our success by finding new and better ways to welcome our renters, support our owners, and increase income for owners to offset increased electricity and cleaning costs.

This past year, many renters who have never stayed here before discovered ORO. Through internet searches, various RV apps, and positive word of mouth, a new wave of renters has found ORO through the rental program and have loved our resort.

The following list includes several highlights from the past year:

- * Introduced ORO to at least 7 renters who purchased properties in ORO this year.
- * Collected more than \$225,000 gross revenue for rentals between May 1 & April 30.
- * Booked more than 6,000 rental nights between May 1 & April 30. The average length of stay was 26 nights.
- * Continued working with owners to improve rental properties and increase income.
- * Identified ways to increase income from renters and reduce program expenses.
- * Implemented a cleaning fee charged to renters of homes to help offset cleaning costs.
- * Adjusted the Passport America discount to increase income for RV Lot owners.
- * Increased RV Lot rental rates and added the Premium Lot classification to improve revenue and stay consistent with local rates.
- * Added rental home classifications with pricing ranges to effectively determine and communicate rental rates within each category.

Per ORO & Regulations, Section F.1.f

All vehicles, including bicycles, must observe posted stop signs and ten (10) MPH

speed limit. Age sixteen (16) is required to operate any motorized vehicle, motor

scooter, golf cart, etc. Bicycles or golf carts operated after dark must have lights and are operated **at the owner's risk.**





If you have Vendors/Visitors coming in for the day, you must call the Gate House with the Vendor/Visitor information (Lot #, Name or Company, Date, etc.) prior to arrival. **The Gate House can be reached at 863-424-0211.** The Gate House can only issue a DAY PASS. For visitors/vendors that will be here for multiple days, you will need to contact the **ORO Office at 863-424-1407** prior to their arrival to obtain a multi-day gate pass.

Per ORO Rules & Regulations, Section M.9

Unit owners expecting guests must notify Safety, calling 863-424-0211, or furnish Safety, in writing, their name and lot number, the name of the guest, and the expected time of arrival and stay. Unit owners may also furnish Safety, in writing, the names of one or more individuals that they wish to host or to whom they wish to deny entry at any time. If a visitor who is not pre-registered arrives, Safety will call the owner to verify entry. If the unit owner's telephone number is not on Safety's list or the telephone is not answered, Safety shall have the sole right to allow or deny access to the park.
