I am from R.I. where I was in the heating business for 27 years. I started driving an oil truck and worked my way up to service supervisor. I have a master pipe fitting license and a PJ2 oil burner's license. After that I went into plumbing, heating and air conditioning sales on the road.

I'm an owner at ORO since 2005 but didn't move here permanently until 2008. I started working in Maintenance shortly after I moved here. In 2009, I started working at the Guard House. Not long after starting this position, I also drove the ORO trash truck because I had a class "B" license. That job lasted until ORO hired a trash removal company.
