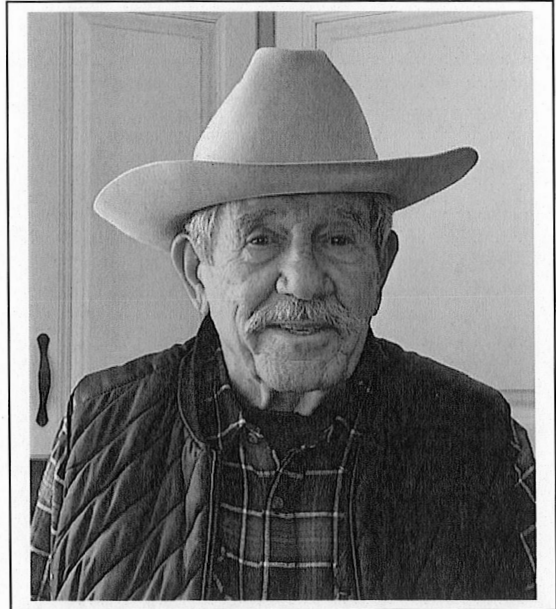


VOTE JOHN BAILEY FOR RE-ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
